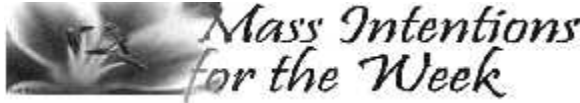

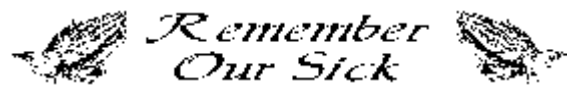

REFLEXIÓN DOMINICAL

El miedo y la falta de valor representan un importante obstáculo para una vida de fe y de amor. También nosotros, al igual que los apóstoles sobre la barca, podemos dejarnos paralizar por el miedo, que puede impedir ver lo cerca que está de nosotros el Señor.

Él es el Emmanuel, Dios-con-nosotros, y es también el Dios de la naturaleza, que comanda las tormentas y todas las fuerzas destructivas: "Él anuncia la paz ... su salvación ya está cerca de sus fieles" (Sal 84); incluso cuando nos parece estar sobre una barca "lejos de la costa, sacudía por las olas, porque el viento es contrario", Él nunca está lejos de ninguno de nosotros.

Como San Pedro, debemos estar dispuestos a arriesgar nuestra seguridad y la excesiva preocupación por nosotros mismos, si queremos que nuestra fe se fortalezca. Hoy el Señor nos dice a cada uno: "Ven". Para responder y para ir hacia Él, a veces, tenemos que cruzar las aguas del sufrimiento. ¿Qué ocurriría, entonces, cuando, sintiendo la fuerza del viento, empezaríamos a tener miedo y a hundirnos? Para superar el miedo se debe seguir el ejemplo de Jesús: "subió al monte a solas para orar". La fe sólo se ve reforzada por la práctica regular de la oración. No olvidemos, por lo tanto, de acostumbrarnos a orar todos los días. Amén.
