### **REFLEXIÓN DOMINICAL**

El evangelio de hoy nos muestra el deseo de Pedro de saber hasta dónde estamos obligados a perdonar. La respuesta del Señor es que no hay límites para el perdón. Esto lo ilustra con la parábola del "ajuste de cuentas": ante el pedido del servidor, el rey le perdona la deuda de "muchos millones". El perdón del rey es enteramente gratuito, lo hace simplemente por "lástima", por amor, no porque piense que un día recibirá lo que se le adeuda.

Pero, el comportamiento del servidor perdonado es contrario al del rey. Su compañero de trabajo "le debía poco dinero"; una suma perfectamente pagable, pese a eso la súplica del deudor no es escuchada. El "siervo malvado" no ha aprendido la lección. En estricta justicia él puede enviar a la cárcel a quien le debe, pero el rey le acaba de mostrar otra justicia, la que se basa en el amor gratuito que no pide nada a cambio. La que considera a las personas en ellas mismas, no por lo que tienen.

Dios ama porque es bueno. Ante la inmensidad de su amor los méritos de las personas son secundarios. Así también deben amar aquellos que creen en Él. El amor de Dios es modelo de nuestra conducta. El Señor está siempre dispuesto a rehacer su alianza, como nos dice hoy la primera lectura; lo cual implica que nosotros igualmente abramos nuestro corazón a los demás. Ante la gratuidad del amor, la pregunta "¿cuántas veces tengo que perdonar?" pierde sentido. Nada hay más exigente que el amor gratuito y sin límites de Aquel que es "Señor de vivos y muertos", como nos dice san Pablo en la segunda lectura.

Hágamos, hoy, que la Palabra de Dios penetre realmente en nuestras vidas y nos ayude a saber perdonar, sabiendo que el amor gratuito es y debe ser la norma de las relaciones que establecemos con nuestro prójimo. Amén.
