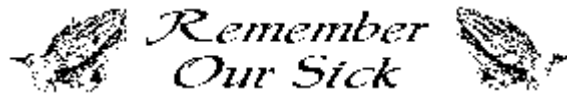

**For families who choose not to use the Weekly Envelope system or Parish Pay an additional \$250 must be paid at the time of registration.**

No re-registration is required for 9<sup>th</sup> Graders Confirmation Candidates.

**REFLEXIÓN DOMINICAL**

Todo aquello que Jesús ha dicho al oído, en secreto y en privado, será predicado públicamente en los techos de los países y ciudades de todo el mundo. Después del descenso del Espíritu Santo, los apóstoles comenzaron a anunciar el Evangelio, con claridad y coraje, cuando han abierto las puertas del Cenáculo, y fueron hacia los cuatro puntos cardinales del universo.

Pese a la oposición que encontraron, se ha hecho conocer el Evangelio cada vez más y cada vez mejor, y cuando el fin del mundo será mucho más inminente, toda la humanidad lo conocerá y lo tendrá en cuenta.

Jesús también dice: "No se preocupen demasiado por el destino del Evangelio, y no tengan miedo de la gente. No teman a nadie excepto a Dios. No es la muerte la mayor desgracia, sino la condenación".

Hay que superar el miedo a la muerte, así como a las persecuciones y a las dificultades de cada día, a través de la fe en la Providencia, que protege incluso el más insignificante entre las aves: el gorrión.

La cosa más bonita que podemos hacer en este mundo, incluso en medio de la persecución y el sufrimiento, es ser un testigo de Jesús. Aunque el martirio no es el destino de todos sus discípulos, cada uno de nosotros siempre y en todas partes debe reconocer su pertenencia a Cristo, con palabras y acciones, con la vida y el comportamiento.

Y esto lo hacemos de una manera especial cuando celebramos la misa, donde en comunión con toda la Iglesia, proclamamos las maravillas que Dios hace a favor de su creación y en favor nuestro.
