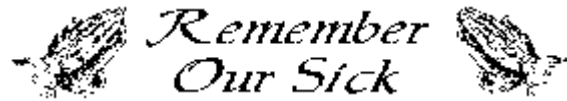

### **REFLEXIÓN DOMINICAL**

El Señor desea ser amado por todos sus discípulos como Él ama al Padre. Él no quiere que nadie perturbe la calidad de este amor ni su intensidad. Tiene que ser perfecto para siempre. Es un amor que no debe conocer ni la noche ni el amanecer, ni siquiera el atardecer o la puesta del sol. Siempre debe ser perfecto, pleno como el sol al mediodía. Ni siquiera una nube momentánea y pasajera debe oscurecerla u ocultarla.

Padre, madre, hijo, hija, no puede disminuir el amor por Cristo. Ni siquiera el amor por la propia vida podrá disminuirla. Para amar a Jesús el Señor se debe estar preparado, incluso, para afrontar el martirio sea aquello cruento o aquello incruento. Jesús quiere el corazón todo para Él y junto al corazón la mente, los pensamientos, la voluntad, los deseos, el alma y el mismo cuerpo. Para lograr ésto, se necesita abandonar un mundo para entrar en otro. Se abandona el mundo de los hombres y se entra en el mundo de la verdad y del amor de Cristo, poniéndose en obediencia perpetua a todos sus mandamientos y aceptando su cruz como condición de ser auténtico discípulo.

Cada uno de nosotros es, ante todo, un discípulo de Jesús y la dignidad de serlo radica en el seguimiento sincero del Señor, huyendo de todo placer momentáneo que ofrece el mundo. El discípulo digno es el cristiano que no camina detrás de las idolatrías que presenta el mundo como es la vida fácil sin sentido ni proyección. Más por el contrario, aunque es arduo, se compromete a vivir el Evangelio en su máxima expresión "amando a Dios y al prójimo como a sí mismo". Ésto sí produce verdadero sentido y esperanza de gozo perpetuo.

Por eso, el triple énfasis de Jesús, en el evangelio de hoy, "no es digno de mí", nos recuerda la triple pregunta de Jesús a Pedro si lo amaba más que todos los demás. Eso significa que hoy el evangelio nos pide a todos amar "más" al Señor para poder amar también a los demás. Jesús puede ser no amado, pero no puede ser amado menos que otro, porque no sería el Señor: "Amarás al Señor tu Dios ...".
