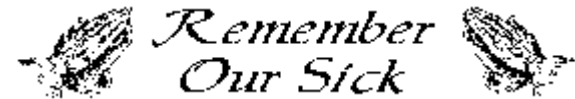

In order to register your child all past tuition must be paid, any sacrament fees owed must be paid and your Church offerings (envelope giving or ParishPay) must be up to date.

For families who choose not to use the Weekly Envelope system or Parish Pay an additional \$250 must be paid at the time of registration.

No re-registration is required for 9th Graders Confirmation Candidates.

Parents of First Graders and new families to the program need to bring the child's Baptism Certificate at registration time.

REFLEXIÓN DOMINICAL

En la ciudad de Galilea, la predicación de Jesús ha conocido el fracaso. A pesar de los milagros realizados en esta ciudad, Jesús no fue escuchado: los sabios e inteligentes se cerraron al Evangelio. Motivo por el cual, Él se alejó de la multitud para tomar en sus manos el pequeño grupo de discípulos desanimados. En cualquier caso, es en la oración donde descubre una vez más el designio del Padre, se siente invadido por la alegría de su bondad y repite, en un Magnificat vibrante, la bienaventuranza de los pobres.

Recurriendo al tesoro de las Escrituras, con el tono de un profeta inspirado, Jesús canta un himno de alabanza a su Padre. Con los ojos renovados por la oración, contempla la paradoja de una salvación escondida a los escribas y fariseos, pero revelada a los humildes que lo siguen. Si Jesús tiene un papel muy especial en esta revelación, es porque vive, en lo más profundo de su ser de la que brota la alabanza, una relación especial con Dios: es el Hijo eterno del Padre.

Sólo Él puede saber hasta qué punto Dios es Padre, y sólo Él puede hacer entrar a sus discípulos en este misterio de amor. El descanso que Jesús les concede después de haberlos enviado en una misión es un signo de la paz más profunda que encontrarán los discípulos en la recepción de su enseñanza, porque Él es el Mesías "manso y humilde de corazón" que predica únicamente la palabra de Dios y que impone sólo aquello que es posible cargar o llevar ya que su "yugo es ligero" y su "carga ligera".

Pero, ¿qué significa para nosotros esta oración de Jesús? Orar con Jesús significa dejar cantar en nosotros su Espíritu, significa abrirse al nombre divino que nos hace hijos capaces de cumplir la voluntad del Padre y, también, significa regocijarse con Él por las maravillas que continúa realizando en favor nuestro. Amén.
