### REFLEXIÓN DOMINICAL

El Evangelio de este Domingo nos trae una dura polémica con los fariseos. Jesús previene a la gente, que se interesa por oír su palabra, y a los discípulos, que no tomen como modelo a los dirigentes religiosos judíos *“porque dicen una cosa y hacen otra”*. Cuestiona su afán de figuración y de disfrutar de privilegios en la sociedad. Como ya había advertido el profeta Malaquías, en la primera lectura de hoy, a los sacerdotes de su tiempo, el único sentido de su función es escuchar y dar gloria al nombre del Señor de los ejércitos. Dar gloria a Dios significa escuchar y poner en práctica su voluntad como lo único absoluto. De eso Jesús había sido modelo: el sentido de su vida era cumplir en todo la voluntad del Padre, realizar los signos de su reinado. Por eso sólo ÉL, el Cristo, es el único Maestro a reconocer y seguir. Por la misma razón recomienda a los discípulos: *“A ningún hombre sobre la tierra lo llamen ‘padre’, porque el Padre de ustedes es sólo el Padre celestial”*.

Aquel, a quien se le conceda una función o una responsabilidad en la comunidad, ha de hacerlo con humildad, no considerándose el centro o la referencia absoluta para los demás, sino el que con su palabra, con sus acitudes y comportamiento coherente recuerda quién es el único Maestro y el único Padre. *“El mayor de entre ustedes – sintetiza Jesús – sea su servidor”*. No se rechaza la función específica de dirección, ni siquiera se insinúa que esté mal ser el mayor. Lo que propone como novedad inspirada en su propio ejemplo es que ese mismo sea el primero en el servicio.

En la segunda lectura de hoy, tomada de la carta a los Tesalonicenses, Pablo confiesa que ejerce el apostolado con el amor de una madre que *“estrecha en su regazo a sus pequeños”*. No pretende ser un maestro que enseña autoritativamente, sino dar el Evangelio dándose él mismo sin escatimar *“esfuerzos y fatigas”*. Evangelizar no es imponer cargas pesadas sobre las espaldas de la gente, sino en primer lugar darse uno mismo. Sólo se anuncia con verdad lo que se vive con coherencia y alegría. Antes de cualquier técnica o metodología evangelizadora se requiere el testimonio de una vida santa, justa e irreprochable y el servicio de la Palabra ofrecido con amor y humildad. Así será recibida *“no como palabra humana, sino como lo que realmente es: Palabra de Dios, que sigue actuando en ustedes, los creyentes”*.

El Evangelio del Señor sólo puede ser transmitido y anunciado con amor, a través de la entrega generosa y del servicio humilde. El Señor nos quiere testigos y servidores de la Palabra, que escuchen y se tomen bien a pecho la gloria de su Nombre. Y la gloria de Dios es que todos nosotros tengamos vida y vida en abundancia. Amén.
