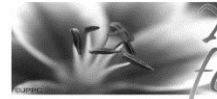

If you gave online through ParishPay, the work of transferring your account to WeShare is done. Visit the ParishPay link on your church website to securely verify your account.

You'll need some information on hand:

1. Your ParishPay Username
2. Last 4 digits of the bank account or credit card used for ParishPay

You'll also need ONE of the following two options:

1. Your email registered with parishPay OR
2. A collection name and the specific amount you donated in the last 6 months.

If you've never donated online before, signing up is easy!

1. Visit your church website and click "Give Online."
2. Click on the collection you wish to donate to.
3. Click "Recurring Donation," then enter your donation amount and frequency.

**REFLEXIÓN DOMINICAL**

El evangelio de hoy nos presenta a Juan el Bautista como alguien que surge repentinamente, "apareció". Él es un enviado, un mensajero. Trae un anuncio que prepara el camino de Jesús. En el desierto, no sólo bautiza sino también llama a la conversión. Es decir, invita a cambiar, a enderezar lo torcido, a buscar la justicia y a preparar el encuentro con el Señor que viene cada día en medio de lo pequeño de este mundo. Juan Bautista representa la función que cumple el Dios que revela su amor y su presencia. Esa revelación llega a su plenitud con Jesús.

El Señor llega porque ama a los suyos y escucha sus penas y sus clamores. No es un Dios que viene por casualidad, sino por amor. Este encuentro feliz es lo que el cristiano ha estado esperando desde el comienzo de su fe, y para eso tiene que dejar los ídolos de este mundo y convertirse al Dios vivo que viene a encontrarse con él. Se trata de un cambio total pues el Espíritu derramará por todo nuestro ser la vida, el amor del Padre y del Hijo.

Ese mensaje anticipatorio lo aporta un hombre austero, vestido con piel de camello y alimentándose de lo que encuentra en el desierto. A él acuden quienes desean prepararse; van al desierto, allí en la frontera de la tierra prometida, en el río Jordán son bautizados

"Consuelen a mi pueblo", dice el Señor. Consolar quiere decir liberar. Eso es lo que ha comenzado a hacer Juan Bautista. Le "habla al corazón" del pueblo de Jerusalén. Es necesario cambiar la raíz de comportamiento personal, pero los resultados deben ser importantes: los valles se levantarán y los montes se bajarán. No es algo superficial.

Juan Bautista da un testimonio de humildad; indica, no obstruye, el camino al Señor. Da una pauta a los seguidores de Jesús, a aquellos que debemos dar testimonio de él. De él, no de nosotros. Una comunidad cristiana que se anuncia y afirma ella misma esconde la presencia del Señor. Vivir la fraternidad y la comprensión al interior de la comunidad cristiana, servir y no buscar privilegios, hará conocer el amor de Dios.

El tiempo de advenimiento es preparación a la Navidad del Señor en la medida en que es tiempo de preparación de nuestro encuentro con Jesús. El Señor cumplirá su promesa y nos invita a un cambio radical en vistas a la acogida que le daremos al acoger a los pequeños y marginados. Amén.
